Classes can be conducted both in Virtually (Virtual Instructor Lead Training (VILT) and in-person (Instructor Lead Training (ILT) formats.

1.	After your Concealed Carry Class (VILT & ILT) The goal of this course is to provide new and seasoned firearm owners/operators who have completed the State of NM approved Concealed Carry Course and begins with NOW WHAT .
2.	Art of Self-Defense Use of Force (VILT & ILT) The goal of this course is to provide new and seasoned firearm owners/operators items for their consideration prior to, during and after an encounter or involvement in a self-defense incident in which Self-Defense measures were employed.
3.	Art of Self-Defense with Firearms (VILT & ILT) The goal of this course is to provide new and seasoned firearm owners/operators items for consideration in the possession, use, carry (open or concealed) with firearms prior to, during and after an encounter or involvement in a self-defense incident.
4.	Basic Pistol - Revolver Cleaning (ILT) Goal: The goal of this course is to provide individuals with the basic operations, use, care and responsibility of firearm ownership/operations.
5.	Basic Rifle Cleaning (ILT) Goal: The goal of this course is to provide individuals with the basic operations, use, care and responsibility of firearm ownership/operations.
6.	Basic Pistol - Revolver Course NRA Blended (VILT & ILT) Goal: The goal of this course is to provide individuals with the basic operations, use, care and responsibility of firearm ownership. Primarily on Pistols and Revolvers.
7.	Basic Pistol - Revolver Course NRA (ILT) Goal: The goal of this course is to provide individuals with the basic operations, use, care and responsibility of firearm ownership. Primarily on Pistols and Revolvers
8.	NM DPS CCW initial class (VILT & ILT) Goal: This course has been specifically designed to address New Mexico Concealed Carry Training requirements and the initial step to achieve.
9.	NM DPS CCW 2 yr & 4 yr renewal (VILT & ILT) Goal: This course has been specifically designed to address New Mexico Concealed Carry Training requirements for those that the 2-year and or 4-year renewal/refresher.
10.	NM DPS CCW for Military (VILT & ILT) Goal: This course has been specifically designed to address the differences between prior military service duty and the privilege of being licensed to carry a concealed handgun in New Mexico and the legally- responsibilities and ramifications of the licensee to be properly trained.
11.	NRA Range Safety Officer (RSO) (VILT & ILT) Goal: This course has been designed to address the requirements and duties of Range Safety Officer and ensure that firearms safety practices are adhered to for both individuals and sponsored events.
12.	Orientation to Handguns All hands-on. The goal of this course is to provide new and prospective firearm owners/operators who are looking to purchase a firearm but are not sure if they are making the best informed decision.
13.	NRA Personal Protection In The Home (PPITH). To develop the basic knowledge, skills and attitude essential to the safe and efficient use of a firearm for protection of self and family, and to provide information on the law-abiding citizen's right to self defense
